Preface

THE SYSTEM FOR THE MEMORIZATION OF THE HOLY QUR'AN

The tradition of memorizing the entire Holy Qur'an, or being a hafiz, has an important place in the Islamic civilization. This education may differ from country to country, from geography to geography. The program in your hands has been prepared on the basis of the method widely used in Turkey.

This method is based on the principle of completing a turn by memorizing a page from the end of each juz and reinforcing the memorizations in the next turns in an average of 25-35 days, by repeating the memorizations made in the previous turns. With this method, it is aimed for the student to complete the memorization of the whole Qur'an in the shortest possible time and in the strongest way depending on the student's ability.

Although the experts have different opinions about the methods, there is a consensus that the ideal age to memorize the Holy Qur'an is the early ages. In this system considered together with the school, the most favorable period for students is to be between the ages of 11-15 (Those who have completed their primary education and started the secondary school).

The Road Map for the Memorization of the Holy Qur'an consists of 8 successive stages. The lessons and contents of each stage of the Road Map have been placed in the program in the form of "general course distribution according to the stages" by taking into account the hafiz training process together with the education in the school.

After the introductory information presented at the beginning of each stage, a "sample weekly course schedule" showing the distribution of the courses of that stage, then the "method of teaching" of the courses, and finally the contents of the courses of the stage are given as a "detailed schedule".


The important aspects of this system, such as the concepts used in memorization of the Qur'an, the training students for memorization of the Qur'an, the method of memorizing the pages of the Qur'an, the method of listening the memorized pages are discussed under the title of "Guidelines of the concepts and the methods of the memorization of the Qur'an".

In the 2nd Chapter, all the forms that will be needed in the stages of the program such as student admission, "Preliminary training", "Preparation for the Memorization", "Trials for the Memorization", "First and Second Years of the Memorization Process", "Repetition of the Memorization" are provided in the Appendix section.


^{*} This program has been prepared by taking into consideration the students who did not know how to read the Qur'an. Those who already have some knowledge of reading the Qur'an can be included in the same program and their deficiencies can be corrected, and their individual progress can be provided by the assistance of the class teacher.

^{**} Social activities are held every day at the preliminary training stage, and at appropriate times on the weekends in the other stages. These activities are organized under various groups of activities such as Sports Activities, Educational Games with Multiple Participation, Quiz Shows, Cultural Activities, Educational Games, Religious Music, Trip and Observation, Computer Presentations.

^{***} In the 6th, 7th and 8th stages, classes to supplement the school courses can be organized on Saturday-Sunday on weekends depending on the need.



1st Stage: The Stage of finding students for the Program



Then brochures and advertisements of the memorization of the Qur'an program are prepared. Brochures and advertisements should contain information about the venues, date, time and requirements, the system and content of the exam. (In formation such as whether it will be a multiple-choice exam, a written exam or an interview, it must be specified in the advertisements in advance). The exam should be carried out in a single center. If it is to be carried out at different venues, attention should be paid to make all of them to be carried out on the same day and time.

Until the student selection exam, several visits are to be made to the determined regions by taking brochures and advertisements.

When coming to the exam, students should be asked to bring their report cards or transcript of the last class they have completed, along with their IDs.

Advertisements for student recruitment are to be broadcasted on radios, TVs and digital platforms (institutional websites) and published in newspapers and magazines. (See for examples Appendix 1)

Advertisements and brochures printed in A3 size papers are to be posted in mosques and non-formal educational courses and distributed to the congregation. Necessary preparations are to be made for its announcements at Friday sermons.

Visits should be made to the school in different regions in order to create an application pool to reach a high level of student standard and to have the program heard throughout the country.

If there are and if the circumstances are suitable, advertisements are placed on billboards at key points of the city.

With the help of imams, opinion leaders and the students studying in non-formal education; and our students who are studying and graduated from our programs, the spectrum of applications is tried to be kept as wide as possible.



2nd Stage: The Stage of Selecting Students



- A The student selection exam is held as stated in the advertisement (in the form of a multiple-choice test, written exam or interview).
- The Examination Committee is composed of at least two people.
- If a multiple-choice test is to be given for student selection, test questions should be prepared according to the level of the class that the student has completed. In the oral interview after the test, students should be evaluated according to:

- Which grade they have completed (grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11),
- What languages they know,
 - Their general standing and moral status,
 - Their behavior, their style, self-expression, the cleanliness and tidiness of their attire during the interview,
- · Whether they have taken lessons from a Qur'an teacher or attended to a program of the memorization of the Qur'an before,
- Their level of reading the Qur'an by having them read parts from the Qur'an, and whether they already know any parts of the Qur'an by heart,
- Commission should also check whether other students from the applying student's village or region previously studied in the program,
- In addition, the student's intelligence, memory, attention and understanding capacity are also measured in the interview. For this, questions such as the ones from the "Sample Questions of Attention and Intelligence" on the next page can be asked.



Sample Questions of Attention and Intelligence

- For the measurement of intelligence, the student is told at least 7 numbers (such as 6, 3, 8, 0, 5, 2, 4) in a mixed manner and then asked to repeat them in the same order; Again, a question like this can be asked: Simple math questions such as "A student doubled the pages of the novel he/she read every day and reached the end of a 200-page book at the end of the 4th day. In how many days did this student read 1/4 of the book? (1 day)" that require the student use his/her logic can also be asked.
- In order to measure **the attention** of the student, questions such as how many people there are in the room, the colors of the clothes of the people in the room, the furniture in the room, etc. can be asked to the student by closing his/her eyes a while after he/she enters the room. Thus, **their photographic memory** can also be measured.
- Their instant memorization capacity can be measured by asking the students to read a section from a poem that they do not know and then recite it by heart.
- After having them read a book in the language that they know, they can be asked to explain what they understand so that **their** understanding capacity can be measured.



By means of the questions such as the above ones, the individual's verbal reasoning, vocabulary, auditory attention and long-term memory are measured.

PS 1.

The student interview form given in Appendix 2 is filled by the Examination Committee.

PS 2.

The interview form is filled in by scoring on a 100-point system. The result is announced after all students finish their interviews. Successful students are taken to preliminary training stage, which is **the 3**rd **stage of the program**.

PS 3.

For the preliminary training stage, students and parents are informed where the education will take place, when it will start and how long it will last. The list of the official documents and personal belongings required to be brought for preliminary training stage is given to the parents in writing, and they are asked to bring them to the summer training program. 3rd Stage: The Stage of Pre-Education

What is the Preliminary training Stage? Preliminary training Course Hours



Students who are successful in the student selection exam are taken to a 2-month preliminary training camp. The curriculum in this camp is planned as 6 days a week, 6 hours a day. 14 hours of the program are reserved for reading the Qur'an, 12 hours for memorization, 2 hours for Islamic creed, 2 hours for acts of worship, 2 hours for the Life of the Prophet Muhammad, 1 hour for ethics, 1 hour for tajweed and 1 hour for memorizing daily supplication. (For example: Table: 3) After the classes end, social activities should be organized. (Sports tournaments, competitions, knowledge and supplication competition, city tours and picnics under the supervision of guides, weekly guidance hours)

Courses to be Taught in the Preliminary training Stage and the Methods of their Teaching:

☑ Reading the Qur'an:

In the first month, the book of Elif-ba, together with the articulation points of the Arabic letters, is taught through practices (Ta'lim). In the second month, the course continues by starting to read the Qur'an.

☑ The Method of Teaching to be applied in the Reading the Qur'an Course:

In the first week of the 2nd month 5 lines every day; in the 2nd week, 7-8 lines per day; in the 3rd week, 10 lines per day; in the 4th week, one page per day is read from the Holy Qur'an. The Qur'an teacher reads the verses a few times, then the students repeat it word for word in chorus. The parts read from the Qur'an are given to the students as homework, the homework will be listened from each student one by one on the following day. Thus, at the end of 1 month, 15-20 pages will be completed. (In the 3rd and 4th weeks, it should be aimed to teach *ikhfa*, *izhar* and *idgham* theoretically and practically while reading and memorizing the Qur'an.) or the program of reading the Qur'an see the **Table 4**.

PS₁

In the course of the Reading the Qur'an, students with good reading levels should be given extra pages to progress more.

☑ Memorization of the Qur'an:

After the 2nd week of the beginning of the course, starting from the supplication Subhanaka, other supplications and chapters given in **Table: 4** are memorized by the students in the given order.

☑ Method of Teaching the Memorization of the Qur'an Course:

Correct way of memorization is carried out by the teacher reading the chapter that will be memorized over and over again in chorus and then the students recite and repeat it one by one. The memorized chapters must be listened from the students one by one in the next lesson.

PS₂

Individual planning should be made for the students who distinguish by their ability to memorize. (Those who can memorize should not be limited by the given curriculum.)

☑ Basic Religious Knowledge:

For the basic religious knowledge, the courses of Islamic creed, acts of worship and ethics will be studied from the books "I'm Learning My Religion 1 and 2". In the Siyar course, the book "My Beloved Prophet" will be used, and in the supplication course, supplications such as the supplications of ritual prayers, the supplication to be recited when waking up in the morning, the supplication to be read when entering the toilet, the supplication to be read when leaving the toilet, the supplication to be recited after adhan, the supplication after eating a meal, the supplication of sayy-id'ul istighfar and the supplication of travel will be memorized.

PS3

In supplication course, Mahmud Sami Ramazanoğlu's book "Supplications and Dhikrs" can be benefited as a reference.

At the end of 2 months, students who are successful in their classes are transferred to the stage of 5-month preparation for the memorization of the Qur'an.



During this period the follow-up tables (For Reading, Appendix 4); (For Memorization Appendix 5) (For Supplication, Appendix 6) will be used.





4th Stage: The Stage of Preparation For Memorization of the Qur'an





This program is planned as **6 days** a week, **4 hours** a day (6 hours on Saturday), considering that it will continue along with the education at school. At this stage, supplementary classes for the education at school can be offered to the students on Saturdays and Sundays according to their grade levels and needs. The sample weekly course schedule is shown in **Table: 5**.

PS₁

Qur'an lessons on weekdays should be planned as 4 lessons per day, 45 minutes each.

PS₂

Students who are successful in the courses at the end of 5 months are taken to the 15-20 days (Maximum 1 month) of trials of memorization of the Qur'an.

PS₃

Follow-up charts will be used in the Preparatory Stage of the Memorization of the Qur'an (For Reading, Appendix 7) (For Memorization Appendix 8).





Courses to be taught in Preparatory Stage and the Methods of Teaching them:

☑ Reading the Qur'an:

Starting from the 2nd juz, it will be read every day in accordance with the schedule given in **Table: 6**, paying attention to the articulation points of the letters and the tajweed rules. In the first two months of this stage, attention should be paid to read in accordance with the method of tahqiq (in accordance with all the rules of tajweed, without shortening the *madds*, in accordance with the teaching methods of the articulation points of the letters) in order to fully master the articulation points of the letters.

☑ The Method of Teaching to be applied in the Reading the Our'an Course:

The teacher of the Qur'an reads the new pages aloud to the students at least once, then the students repeat it word by word in chorus. The section read is given to the students as homework, it will be listened from each student one by one on the following day. Every student who is on the same page follows his/her friend while his/her friend is reading, and it is not allowed for him/her to be busy with other pages. The same practice continues every day. Thus, at the end of 5 months, the students reach the page 243. (approximately 12 juz will be completed).

PS₁

At the end of the 5th month, it is important for the student to reach a level that he/she can read 1 page in 2-2.5 minutes, in order to start memorization of the Qur'an.

☑ Tajweed:

At this stage, it will be ensured that the theoretical subjects of tajweed are completed in four months. In the last month, the students will be asked to apply strictly what they have learned in the lessons.

☑ Ta'lim:

In the ta'lim course, the students go over the subject of the articulation points of the letters one more time. Special characteristics of letters are taught in the course. Methods of recitation of the Qur'an are introduced by name (tahqiq, tadwir, hadr, tartil) and illustrated with sample recitations. At this stage, students start with the recitation of the supplication of subhanaka and study the recitation of other supplications and chapters from the Qur'an upto the chapter al-Fil. In regards to the method of recitation, the students first read in chorus, word by word. Then, the teacher needs to be sure that the students pronounce the letters correctly by engaging with **each student one by one.**

☑ Basic Religious Knowledge:

For basic religious knowledge, the courses of itiqad, worship, siyar and ethics will be benefited from the books "I am learning my religion, Islam 7-8".

☑ Memorization of the Qur'an:

In the first two weeks, the memorizations made during the Preliminary Training phase will be gone over and strengthened. For the contents of the program see **Table 6**.

Method of Memorization: First the students read to their teacher the chapters or lines that they will memorize, and their teacher corrects their mistakes, if there is any. Then they start memorizing verse by verse. After that the memorized verses will be combined. Each student has one of the classmates listen to his/her memorization to make it sound and free from errors. The following day, the teacher listens to the students one by one and checks their memorization. The most important point to be considered at this stage is that from that moment on, each student will progress according to his/her individual ability. Therefore, the method of collective action will not be suitable for listening and checking the memorizations.

While the teacher listens to the students' memorization one by one, he/she will definitely follow the student's personal mushaf and correct his/her mistakes by drawing on it special signs showing the errors with a pencil.

The application of this method is to prevent the same errors (*galat*) from repeating in the next recitations. Error signs are shown in **Table: 7,** and their application is illustrated on a sample verse. A copy of the table showing these signs should be given to each student, and pasted on the first page of their mushaf. The meaning of the signs should be clearly explained to the students.

5th Stage: The Stage of Memorization Trials





Students who successfully complete the preparatory stage for memorization, which lasts for 5 months, start to practice memorization, which will last for a maximum of 15-20 days.

In the stage of memorization trials, pages in 3 different categories as easy, medium and hard will be selected and given to the students as homework. It is measured in how many hours the easy pages can be memorized, and whether the pages with medium hardship can be memorized in half a day, and the difficult pages can be memorized in one day.

While listening to the page given to the student as assignment, the student's personal mushaf should be followed and his/her errors should be drawn with a pencil. As in the sample table given in Appendix 9, errors will be counted and filled according to the appropriate headings in the table.

A maximum of 4 trials should be made per day. The page that the student cannot memorize or memorize poorly should not be given as an assignment in the next trial.

The form for memorization trials is kept separately for **each student.** The completed form is then stored in the personal file of each student.

Easy pages and pages with medium difficulty are given as assignment to be memorized during the day. The difficult pages should be listened to as a lesson the following day. If the capacity is observed in the student, the trial pages can be increased for those who can memorize more pages in a day.

The results of the trials are evaluated by a commission. Students who are considered to be capable to pass to the next stage will start the stage of the memorization of the Qur'an by filling the form (Stage of Memorization Trials Student Information Form) in the Appendix 10.

Students' initiation to memorization of the Qur'an is performed in the form of a beautiful memorization ceremony (Bad'i Hifz Program), in which students are given gifts to increase their motivation.





THE CONCEPTS AND METHODS OF MEMORIZATION OF THE QUR'AN

A. CONCEPTS USED IN MEMORIZATION OF THE QUR'AN



Completing all 30 juz by memorizing 1 page from the end of each juz is called the First Turn. Completing 30 juz by memorizing 2 pages from the end of each juz is called the Second Turn.

RAW

The page to be memorized for the first time is called the **Raw page**. (Each new page or pages memorized while memorizing the whole Qur'an)

FINE

The page that is memorized in previous turns is called **Fine Page**. The page which will be memorized for the first time in the new turn is called **Raw Page**.

REPETITION -

In order to strengthen his memorization, the first recitation of the whole Qur'an by heart completed by the student who memorized the Qur'an is called **First Repetition**. The number of the repetition changes with the number of the recitation of the whole Qur'an. If for instance the student completes the recitation of the whole Qur'an by heart ten times, it is called **tenth repetition**.



B. THE PROCEDURE FOR THE MEMORIZATION OF THE QUR'AN

Since the revelation of the Qur'an, many different methods have been applied in different regions and cultures in memorization of the Qur'an. Today, a unique memorization model has been developed by almost every region in line with their own needs. In our memorization system, which we will describe below, students follow the following stages;

First Turn: If If a student who has just started memorization of the whole Qur'an will memorize 1 page every day, he/she will start memorization from 20th page of the 1st Juz. The next page he/she will memorize will be the 20th page of the 2nd Juz. In this way, he/she completes 30 juz and memorizes 30 pages in total at the end of 30 days. An example is shown in Table: 8.

The second turn: the student memorizes the 19th page of the 1st Juz as raw and recites it before his/her teacher; he/she recites it together with page 20th page of the 1st juz as fine page. He/she completes his/her second turn by memorizing 19th and 20th pages of all 30 juz and reciting them before his/her teacher. Those who complete the second turn will be memorized 60 pages from the Qur'an in total. In this way, he/she will have strengthened the 20th pages of all juz that he/she had memorized in the previous turn. An example is shown in Table: 9.

Third Turn: The student who starts the 3rd turn recites 18th page as raw, 19th and the 20th page as fine pages before his/her teacher. By following this method, 18th, 19th, and 20th pages of every juz are memorized. Those who successfully completes the third turn will be memorized 90 pages in total. In this way, the 19th and 20th pages of every juz which were memorized in the previous turns will be strengthened (become finer). A sample of third turm is shown in **Table: 10**.

PS₁

The students who have the ability to memorize more that one page a day should not be given the assignment of memorizing two rawn pages from the same juz, but instead they should be given one raw page from the following juz as an assignment. Because in this way, the completion time of one turn will be less than a month. This will give the student the opportunity to repeat and strengthen the fine page before forgetting it, and will provide a great advantage.

PS₂

During the memorization process, it is very important to maintain the memorized pages in memory and to preserve them. The most basic and only way to achieve this is to repeat the memorized pages at regular intervals without giving a chance to forget them.

For example: A student who memorizes 1 raw page every day will have a great advantage if he/she recites before his/her teacher just the raw pages that he/she has memorized during the week at the end of the same week. When this method is applied, it will be possible to get more raw pages and to complete the memorization in a shorter time, permanently and robustly, without having to spend too much time on the so-called fine pages in the next turn.



C. THE METHOD OF MEMORIZATION OF A PAGE

First, the teacher reads the page to be memorized by the student (especially in the first turns), and the student listens, then the student reads it to the teacher, and the teacher listens. The teacher helps the student by underlining the words or phrases that the student reads incorrectly, and has him/her repeat the place where the error was made until the errors are corrected. In addition, the student's attention will be drawn to the words that are likely to be read incorrectly on the memorized page, and these words are taught to the student.

- Students' attention is drawn to similar (*mushabih*) words and verses on the page in order to facilitate memorization and prevent mistakes.
- After the teacher's corrections, the student should read the page which he/she will memorize at least 15 times aloud. Thus, by means of using his/her senses of sight, hearing and reading, familiarity will be increased and the speed and durability of memorization will be ensured.
- ▶ Memorization is done from the beginning of the page, and descending word-by-word, line-by-line towards the end of the page.
- Every memorized verse is **repeated by heart** at least 3 times. When the second verse is memorized, it is repeated 3 times. Then the two are combined and **recited** 3 times. However, having a friend or teacher listen to every 5 lines of the memorized part is essential in terms of checking and strengthening the memorization. The student who memorizes the raw pages by this method applies the same method to the fine pages.
- The assignment, prepared in this way the day before, will be repeated on the next day, and the raw and fine pages will be read to a friend and thus be ready to be presented to the teacher.
- ≥ Each memorized section (verse, page, chapter, juz) should be linked with a subsequent one. Thus, a unity will be formed in the mind of the student and it will be possible to make the page-chapter transition without difficulty.







D. THE METHOD OF LISTENING THE MEMORIZED SECTIONS

- It is essential that the memorization process is completed under the supervision of the same teacher with whom it started so that the student's memorization is not interrupted and his/her motivation continues.
- In order for the teacher to focus better and to reduce the factors that may distract the student and as a sign of respect to the teacher, students should go to the teacher and present their assignments.
- If the student gets stuck while listening to his/her assignment, the teacher should help the student to remember himself by saying him/her either to restart from the beginning of the verse or from the previous verse, instead of telling him/her right away the part that he/she forgot.
- A maximum of 3 reminding (word, letter, vowels, madd) should be made on a page. In case the reminders exceed 3, the student should be asked to prepare the assignment again and come back.
- ▶ It is very important to repeat the memorized pages in a certain period (turns) in order for the memorization to be strong. In principle, until the 10th turn, the repetition of the previously memorized (Fine pages) should be at least as careful as the raw pages.
- ▶ Until the 10th turn, the fine pages should not be neglected by listening only the raw pages from the student. On the other hand, special practices can be adopted and performed for students with very strong memorization skills and capacities.





It is very important that the students present their assignments every day and that the turn takes place at the latest every 35 days. Even during this time, the fine pages memorized before can be forgotten. Students who cannot submit an assignment on its specific day may take up to 40-50 days to repeat their old memorized sections, so it becomes very difficult to repeat the fine pages in the next turn, and the effort and time spent for this task increase. This situation affects the motivation of the students negatively, prolongs the memorization process and reduces its strength.

It should be ensured that the daily assignment is presented to the teacher as a whole at once, not as raw or fine pages separately. (Example: Assume that there is a student who had memorized 10 pages from each juz before and gets 2 raw pages as an assignment to memorize on the new turn. While presenting his/her assignment to his/her teacher, he/she recites 2 raw pages in the morning and then some time later 10 fine pages to his/her teacher. Such a practice done out of concern to submit the daily assignment on time may detach the student from the understanding that memorization of the Qur'an is a task that needs to be carried out in integrity. By not showing the same care that the student shows for memorizing the raw pages to repeating the fine pages, the student may both end up with a weak memorization and also break the chapter-page unity in his/her mind.

If possible, study groups consisting two or four student should be formed and the students in each group should listen to each other before submitting their assignments to the teacher.

≥ It should be ensured that the student prepares the memorization assignment (raw + fine pages) completely in the evening and repeats it enough times before going to bed.

Applying the so-called "back-up method" in memorization of the Qur'an will also ensure the durability of the memorization and the continuity of the submission of the assignments due to the sleeping over it for a couple of days. (The method that for example a student who goes on the 10th turn and will present the 9th juz on Monday, also prepares only the Raw pages assignment of the following two days (i.e. Tuesday and Wednesday) is called back-up method)

Memorizing and presenting assignments to the teacher should be done in hadr style.







6th Stage: The Stage of Memorization (1st Year)



Based on the 12-month long evaluations, students who are deemed to be talented enough to be a hafiz pass to first year of the stage of the memorization of the Qur'an. Each student should use their own mushaf while memorizing and presenting his/her memorization assignments. Each student's mushaf should contain **Table: 7** that shows the errors and the signs representing them.

Courses to be Taught in the Stage of Memorization (1st Year) and Their Teaching Methods:

✓ Memorizing the Holy Qur'an:

Students submit their teacher the memorizations that they have made as much as the hours in their weekly curriculum, the example of which is given in **Table: 11**. The points to be paid attention to while listening to the memorization assignments of the students are stated under the title "**The Method of Listening the Memorized Sections**" in the "**Guidelines of the Concepts and Methods of Memorization**". The assignment results of the students will be recorded on the memorization assignments follow-up chart. The memorization assignments follow-up chart is given in Appendix 12.

☑ Tajweed:

At this stage, the subjects of articulation points of the letters and their characteristics and other theoretical subjects of taweed will be examined and then the students will be asked to practice them.

☑ Ta'lim:

The chapters of the Qur'an from Chapter al-Fil to Chapter al-Naba, that have been listened by the teacher from each student one by one, will be recorded on the follow-up chart. The follow-up chart of ta'lim lessons is given in Appendix 13.

PS₁

The hours of the Qur'an lessons on weekdays should be planned as 4 lessons per day, 45 minutes each.

PS₂

Provided that the above weekly schedule is maintained, supplementary lessons for the school courses can be arranged for those who need it, at appropriate times after the 6th Class on Saturdays and Sundays.

PS 3

The performance of a student recorded in **the memorization assignments follow-up chart** throughout the year is taken into consideration in the end-of-semester evaluation carried out by the Memorization of the Qur'an Follow-up Committee. In addition, an evaluation is made about each student according to the "**End of Year Student Assessment Form**" given in Appendix 11, and students whose success is below 50% or who are deemed to be unable to continue their memorization training for various reasons will not be allowed to continue their training. However, such students will be placed in a **program of repetition** until the completion of the semester, so that they do not forget the memorized sections they have completed so far. However such unsuccessful students should be kept in the program in such a way that they do not disturb the harmony of the successful students who continue their memorization program.







7th Stage: The Stage of Memorization (2nd Year)



Students who achieve more than 50% success according to The memorization assignments follow-up chart (Appendix 12) in the first year of the Stage of the Memorization can continue to the second year of the Stage of the Memorization if they are deemed appropriate by the commission. This program is planned to be as 8 months. Weekly lessons and their hours are shown in the table below. Each student will use their own mushaf while memorizing and submitting their assignments to their teacher. Each student's mushaf should contain Table: 7 that shows the errors and the signs representing them.

Courses and Teaching Methods to be Taught in the 2nd Year of the Hafiz Process:

☑ Memorizing the Holy Qur'an:

As shown in **Table: 12**, the students are listened to by their teacher every day on a one-by-one basis in the practical course hours. The points to which attention should be paid while listening to the memorizations assignments of the students are stated under the title "**The Method of Listening the Memorized Sections**" of the Guidelines. The memorization assignments follow-up chart is given in Appendix 12.

☑ Ta'lim:

From Chapter al-Naba to Chapter al-Mulk (29th Juz), each student will be **treated with on a one-by-one basis** and the evaluations about the chapters listened to by their teacher will be recorded on the follow-up chart. Ta'lim Lessons Follow-Up Chart is given in Appendix 14.

PS₁

Provided that the sample weekly schedule given in **Table: 12** is maintained, supplementary lessons for the school courses can be arranged for those who need it at appropriate times on Saturdays and Sundays.

PS 2

The hours of the Qur'an lesson on weekdays should be planned as 4 lessons per day, 45 minutes each. Lessons can also be done in blocks.

PS 3

At this stage, no concessions should be given to the students in regards to applying the rules of tajweed, and they should be asked to apply those rules strictly.





8th Stage: The Stage of Repetition



Students who complete the memorization of the whole Qur'an repeat their memorization within 8 months at the latest in accordance with the application provided in the "Memory Strengthening Program" given in **Table: 14**. The assignments submitted in the repetition period should also be recorded in The memorization assignments follow-up chart (Appendix 12) in a regular manner as in the memorization of the Qur'an stages of the program.

5 th Repetition	Every day, 3 juz will be listened to as an assignment in hadr style from the student who starts the fifth repetition. If the student can handle, 5 juz can also be given as assignment.
6 th Repetition	Every day, 5 juz are taken as a lesson in hadr method from the student who starts the sixth repetition. If the student can handle, 10 juz can also be given as assignment.
7 th Repetition	Every day, 10 juz are taken as a lesson in hadr method from the student who starts the seventh repetition. If it can handle the capacity, 15 juz can also be given as assignment.
8 th Repetition	Every day, 15 juz are taken as a lesson in hadr method from the student who starts the eighth repetition. If the student can handle, 30 juz can also be given as assignment.



Courses to be Taught in the Stage of Memorization Repetition and the Methods of Their Teaching:

☑ Memorizing the Holy Qur'an:

Every day, the student is listened to by his/her teacher, as shown in the "memory repetition period sample weekly lesson schedule" in Table: 13.

☑ History of the Qur'an Lesson:

In this stage while strengthening their memorization, the students who have completed the memorization of the whole Qur'an will be taught the following subjects in the History of the Qur'an lesson:



History of the Qur'an

Memorization of the Qur'an and its writing; compilation; duplication; punctuation, insertion of the vowel signs; and types of recitation,



Parts of the Our'an

Chapter, verse, hizb, juz; information about Meccan-Medinan chapters, names and numbers of the chapters,



PS

Supplication of Khatm al-Qur'an (Supplication recited after finishing the whole Qur'an), which is one of the supplications to be memorized by the servants of religious duties, should also be memorized in this stage of the program by the students who completed the memorization of the whole Qur'an.



Verses related to legal matters arranged by subjects

The verses related to the legal matters specified in the table given in Appendix 14 in chapter two should be taught to the students, and they should memorize the meanings of those verses together with their subject headings.


